Forms submitted by December 1st will be included on our website and printed in the Winter edition of our quarterly magazine (The Water Gram). Forms submitted after December 1st but prior to February 28th will be posted on our website only.

IRWA Board of Directors' Eligibility:

All Board of Director positions are for a two year term. No director is entitled to compensation except for reimbursement of reasonable expenses for Association business. No former Association employee whose employment has been terminated for cause shall be eligible for election to the Board of Directors. No person may become an employee if he/she is a member of the Board of Directors of IRWA or at least One Hundred eighty-two (182) days has expired from the time he/she was last a member of the Board of Directors of the IRWA.

The duties of the Board of Directors are as follows:

- a) To conduct and supervise the affairs of the Association, including the designation of committees.
- b) To take charge of and be responsible for the property of the Association's finances and the proceedings of the Association.
- c) To initiate, supervise, and approve plans and programs designed to achieve the objectives and purposes of the Association.
- d) To implement policies, programs or plans adopted at the annual meeting of the members.
- e) To determine policies of the Association consistent with the objectives and purposes of the Association as set out in the Articles of Incorporation.
- f) To provide for and attend annual and special meetings of the Association.
- g) To arrange for the annual audit of the Association by a certified public accountant.
- h) To provide for the dissemination of information to the members and to the public, as may be needed to provide suitable publicity for the work and status of the Association.
